 - Inflatable PFDs *Optional, but must be auto-inflatable and in addition to the required Type III vests. Must be inspected annually*
 - Spare CO2 cylinders (2) *If inflatable PFDs are onboard*
 - Life Ring 30" min with attached heaving line bag
 - Flare Kit *Expired flares may be kept aboard but should be stowed in separate location and clearly labeled "Expired"*
 - Pollution Placard
 - MARPOL Trash Placard
 - CO Detector *ABYC 24.7.2 Detectors shall be located to monitor the atmosphere in the main cabin and each sleeping area.*
 - Smoke Detector (1/stateroom, salon)
 - CO Hazard Warning Sticker
 - Handheld Compressed Air Horn and 1 Spare Can of Compressed Air

Optional equipment such as a life raft, EPIRB, or immersion suit must be inspected and/or serviced per manufacturer recommendation.
